


Table Games Dashboard for Dealers and Pit Bosses

The Table Games Dashboard is where a User can update information that is displayed on the Table Floor Games iPads.

Once a Pit is selected, CastNET will display all of the Table Floor Games that have been assigned to that specific Pit. A User can then select each individual Table Floor Game and update the “Status (Open/Closed)”, “Dealer” or “Min/Max” assigned to each Table Game device.

Pit – Select the Pit you wish to view. CastNET will display the Table Floor Games assigned to that Pit.

Reset Button – This will set the Table Floor Game to its default settings. Includes: Status, Dealer, and Min/Max.

Edit Button – Once selected a form will open where a user can change values of each table game.

Game – Current game assigned to each table Floor Game.

Graphic – This is assigned when you create a Floor Game entry. This is view only.

Status – A user can change the status of a table to Open, Closed, Reserved or Tournament.

Dealer – If applicable, you can assign a Dealer Profile to each Table Floor Game.

Note: Smoking and Orientation are view only. However, you can configure these options when you create or edit a Floor Game.

To update a table game in Dashboard view, follow these steps:

1. Log in to CastNET.
2. Select Dashboard Access.
3. Select the desired Pit.
4. Select the Edit button and fill out form or select desired drop-down data.
5. Select Save.

Note: Once you save, your Table Game device will update.
